- EXTRA ITEMS: bring shoes for running around, sandals/flip flops for the beach, extra pairs of socks, a white clothing item for tie dye, and two towels.
- QUIET TIME: You may want to bring books, journals, pens or pencils, postcards to mail home (remember it helps to pre-address and pre-stamp them!), etc for this time.
- Please DO NOT send candy or snacks in your child's bag, it will only be taken to the Dean's cabin as we do not want the stored food to attract ants to the cabins. If you wish to bring treats for your camper, please turn it in at check in and we will distribute it to your camper each day at snack time.
- **Pajama Dinner:** This year, we're having a pajama night! We'll dress in our pajamas and have a special breakfast for dinner. Please bring pajamas that can go outside and still keep your child warm.

We try our best to honor requests for friends to be in the same cabin. However, we cannot guarantee that campers will be in the same small group.
